The AC Unit for the server room crashed and we are using a portable until repairs can be made.

During the week of heavy rains (9 inches in SR) the ground water level rose and we had seepage into the center. Brad Flarharty, CMCM member and "volunteer of the month" and staff keep the water at bay with a wet/dry shop vac. We are installing a sump pump in the alley to prevent the water table from reaching those levels. We replaced the base plate and drywall with waterproof material. Due to the rains and subsequent flooding we canceled one class and one studio reservation.

We have added a "lighting" class to our schedule of offerings.

Sam Long, our Digital Media Manager, is setting up our web-streaming server. It will be able to broadcast multi streams and live streams. We are creating a menu of options for our pay for fee services for cities and other organizations that would utilize these services.

The Civil grand jury visited the CMCM center and toured the facilities.
